

Performer Etiquette Tips

1. Arrive 30 minutes early to every event, ready to play.
2. Be in full costume before guests arrive, including hat and accessories.
3. Smile and stay in character while visible - even during setup.
4. Avoid using your phone in front of guests unless it's an emergency.
5. Play appropriate music for the vibe - upbeat for cocktail hour, soft for dinners.
6. Take requests politely, but only if you're comfortable performing the song.
7. Respect the event planner or host as the point of contact - check in with them first.
8. Stay positive and professional - you're part of the couple's once-in-a-lifetime day.
9. Help other Wally team members if needed - we're all part of the same show.
10. No alcohol or outside food while performing - even if offered.
11. Thank the host at the end and help load out quietly and efficiently.
