- 1. Arrive 30 minutes early to every event, ready to play.
- 2. Be in full costume before guests arrive, including hat and accessories.
- 3. Smile and stay in character while visible even during setup.
- 4. Avoid using your phone in front of guests unless it's an emergency.
- 5. Play appropriate music for the vibe upbeat for cocktail hour, soft for dinners.
- 6. Take requests politely, but only if you're comfortable performing the song.
- 7. Respect the event planner or host as the point of contact check in with them first.
- 8. Stay positive and professional you're part of the couple's once-in-a-lifetime day.
- 9. Help other Wally team members if needed we're all part of the same show.
- 10. No alcohol or outside food while performing even if offered.
- 11. Thank the host at the end and help load out quietly and efficiently.
